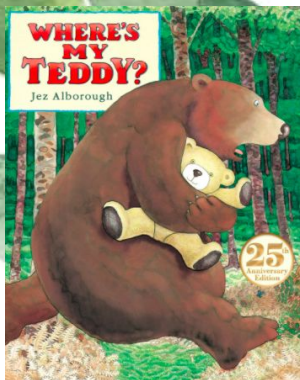
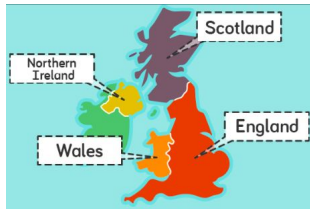


DID YOU KNOW?

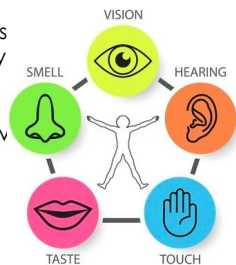
LEARN MORE BY COMBINING LEARNING AT SCHOOL WITH LEARNING AT HOME
