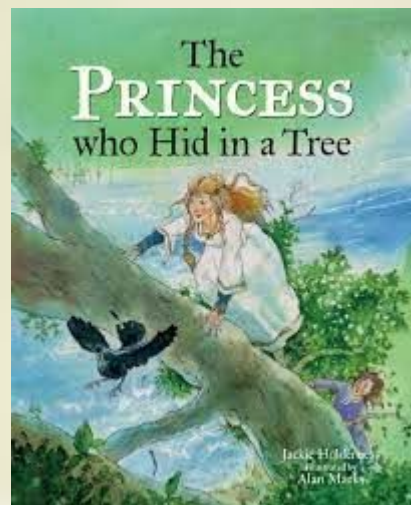


The Anglo-Saxons

What are reversible changes?

- In science, reversible changes are very useful.
 - Solids, liquids and gases all have definitions.
- The water cycle is essential for life. When it does not rain for a long time, it is called a drought.
- Some materials change state when they are heated or cooled (change of temperature). Sometimes changes are reversible such as when you boil water or melt chocolate.
